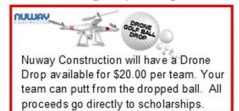

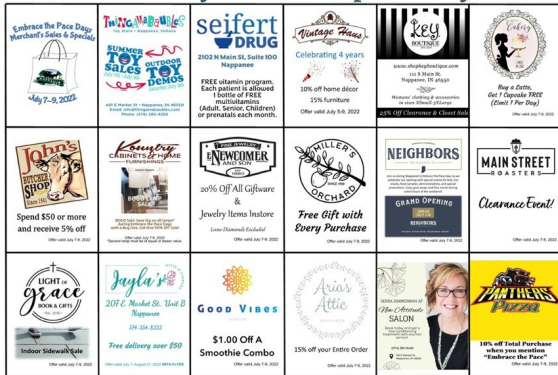

MINOR LEAGUE BASEBALL IS COMING TO ELKHART COUNTY!!



**Elkhart County Miracle Baseball, Inc. is bringing The Northern League
(the oldest & most accomplished league of the Independent Leagues) to Nappanee in 2023!**

The local team will be called the Elkhart County Miracle, and will consist of a 30 to 35 man roster. It will be made up by top-tier, college-eligible and minor league prospects from all over the country.

The 55-game home & away schedule features games beginning in late May and ending the second weekend of August. Home games will be played at the brand new baseball complex on the campus of NorthWood High School, in Nappanee.

The baseball front office is compromised by three executives with past minor league experience. Included is Baseball America's Executive-of-the-Year, John Baxter; former Seattle Mariner draft pick and Notre Dame Quarterback, Evan Sharpley; and one-time Chicago White Sox minor league broadcaster, Craig Wallin.

It is estimated the three-month economic impact generated by the team will top \$1,000,000, with a projected first-year attendance over 30,000 fans!

The Northern League was founded in 1902. Teams are privately owned, self-sufficient, and compromised of players working the way to their major league dream. The league features teams from across Northern Indiana and Chicagoland.

In the past 10 years alone, over 100 players have been drafted to Major League Baseball Clubs; Hank Aaron, Orlando Cepeda, Lou Brock, Gaylord Perry, Jim Palmer, Roger Maris, and Don Larsen are among the players who began their MLB career path in the Northern League.

The Elkhart County Miracle is the latest Northern League franchise addition, and is owned by Elkhart County Miracle Baseball, Inc.

Minor league baseball brings added-value and revenue, is a great addition for sports complexes, increases tourism, helps to brand a community, and brings affordable family fun to the area!
